

NOTIFICATION.

Dacca.—No. 933r.—20th January 1939.—
Whereas the Board of Revenue, Bengal, as the Court of Wards, charge of the estate of Srj. Sarajubala De Srj. Ananda Kumari Debi and Mr. Ramayan Roy Chowdhury, Wards of Court, known as the Bhowal Wards Estate in the district of Dacca and the Manager of the said estate as attorney of Mr. Ramendranaraya Roy, a proprietor of the said estate (in accordance with decree in Title Suit No. 38 of 19 in the 1st Additional Judge's Court, Dacca, and order in Civil Rule No. 1361F of 1936 of the High Court in Calcutta), have represented in writing to the Collector of Dacca their desire that the land described below, which forms part of the Bhowal Protected Forest under notification No. 38 For., dated 12th January 1934, as corrected by erratum N 14177 For., dated 17th July 1937, should no longer be managed as protected forest:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by section 38 of Indian Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), and with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (X of 1897), the Governor is pleased to amend the said notification so as to exclude the said land

from the lands specified in the schedule to the said notification:—
