

NOTIFICATION.

Dacca.—No. 25211For.—30th November
 Whereas the Board of Revenue,
 as the Court of Wards in charge of
 Estate of Srj. Sarajubala Debi, Srj.
 da Kumari Debi and Mr. Ramnarayan
 Chowdhury, Wards of Court, known as
 Bhowal Wards Estate in the district of
 Dacca and the Manager of the said Estate
 as the agent of Mr. Ramendranarayan Roy,
 proprietor of the said Estate (in accordance
 with a decree in Title Suit No. 38 of 1935 in
 the Additional Judge's Court, Dacca, and
 in Civil Rule No. 1361F of 1936 of the
 High Court in Calcutta), have represented
 by writing to the Collector of Dacca that
 the land described below, which is a
 part of the Bhowal Protected Forest
 notified by notification No. 38For., dated
 12th January 1934, as corrected by
 notification No. 4177For., dated 17th July
 1937, should be managed as Protected Forest.

Therefore, in exercise of the power
 conferred by section 38 of the Indian Forest
 Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), read with section 21
 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (X of 1897),
 the Governor is pleased to amend the said

notification so as to exclude the said land
 from the lands specified in the schedule to
 the said notification.
